



## SWBC Youth Retreat 2021 December 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> Camp Copass, Denton Texas

### Rules

- All attendees must have a Christ-like attitude, respect each other, and show Christ's love to Camp Copass employees and other guest with whom we come in contact with during our stay at the camp.
- All cell phones must be turned off during the conference sessions.
- Attendance to all sessions and activities is mandatory.
- All socializing must be done in public. There should be no public displays of affection or other inappropriate behaviors between boys and girls.
- All clothing should be modest, and not drawing attention away from the Lord.
- ANY MEDICATION at the retreat, PRESCRIPTION or NON-PRESCRIPTION, should be used only with the knowledge and supervision of camp coordinators.
- No tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, fireworks or knives are to be brought to the retreat.
- Boys are not allowed in girl rooms and girls are not allowed in boys rooms.
- No one is allowed to leave during the retreat without permission from the retreat directors.

### DETAILS REGARDING COVID-19

Acknowledgment: By choosing to attend youth retreat 2021, you acknowledge that there is an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 in any place where people are present and the southwest brethren Conference does not guarantee, warrant, or represent that you and/or your guests will not be exposed to or infected with COVID-19 either before, during, or after the event. Although we intend to comply with local, state, and federal guidelines, you further acknowledge and understand that the risks of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 may result from your own actions, inactions, negligence or recklessness, as well as from the actions, inactions, negligence or recklessness of others, including without limitation the Southwest Conference, Southwest Conference volunteers, guests, and members of the general public.

## Attendance

We require any person to avoid attending if they have been exposed to COVID-19 within 7 days of the event, or if they have had a fever of 100.4 in the last 72 hours, or have had two or more of the following symptoms within the last 72 hours: a new loss of smell or taste, difficulty breathing, muscle pains, headache, chills, or gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, diarrhea, vomiting. At this time, wearing a mask is not a requirement during this event, but that is subject to change.

### COVID-19 Statement

Southwest brethren conference is committed to following all recommended health and safety guidelines for each event.

This will include:

- Wearing face coverings (if required locally at the time of the event)
- Offering hand sanitizer
- Additional cleaning measures
- Social distancing in seating, ingress and egress, and queuing lines

We will communicate health policies and protocols during the retreat and appreciate your understanding as guidelines are subject to change throughout the year.
